

MOVE DAY CHECKLIST

Relax, take a deep breath, and pat yourself on your back....YOU did it! Now, get PLENTY of rest the night before the move.

- Make sure your cell phone/charger, jewelry, medications, glasses, car keys, handbag, checkbook, and anything you need to get your hands on right away is stored in a place that the movers will not accidentally pack! We'll designate a "safe place" or provide you with a box to store these things a few days prior to the mover's arrival.
- There could be anywhere from 3-4 movers each day, so have at least 4 envelopes daily with a tip for each one. We suggest at least \$25 inside each envelope or 5-10% of the total bill divided by # of movers.
- For those extremely hot days, please have water bottles available in the refrigerator to offer to the movers or, if your refrigerator has a dispenser outside the door, please provide disposable cups for their use.
- Don't forget about your pets! Plan to keep them in a safe place so they do not run out the door, or get injured from so many people and boxes moving throughout your home. This is a good da to send your pet for a spa day at the groomers.

- There will be lots of movers and boxes everywhere, and it does get noisy with things getting taped and furniture being wrapped with blankets and plastic. Make plans to enjoy the day. It's not very safe to be in a smaller place with 4 movers, 2-3 move-in team members, plus lots and lots of boxes.
- Even with the vaccine, CDC recommends social distancing. Every effort is made to have the minimum # of movers/workers onsite, while still being able to complete the project in a timely manner. Please allow us to remain safe while working, which in turn gives us the peace of mind that you will also be safe!
